CCTV is part of a network of churches that provide support to several meaningful ministries and projects in South Africa including the **Refilwe Bophelo Clinic** (Sister Didi's clinic) and **Thembalethu**, a ministry to children who are suffering from AIDS related terminal diseases.

Although CCTV isn't joining in to make the mission trip this summer, we want to support these ministries and those who are traveling to South Africa to serve with them. With your gifts to mission outreach, we have purchased medical supplies such as adult and children's vitamins, antibiotic ointments, and other non-prescription drugs that will be sent with the mission team traveling to **South Africa from July 10 - 21**. We are also sending "comfort dolls" that our CCTV Crafters made that are to be given to the child patients at Thembalethu.

The SA Ministry Network Team will be serving with several of our ministry partners:

Gabriel Foundation - Led by **Zanele Mchunu**; provides education, community training, and spiritual empowerment.

House of Prayer Church - Led by **Pastor Musa**; provides spiritual training and hope to residents in a rural, impoverished area in the Drakensburg Mountains.

Inspired Hope - Led by **Paneng Mohlakoana**; uses asset-based community development to help people in the Khetani township discover and use their resources to improve their lives (sewing classes, computer classes, community garden, etc.)

Thembalethu - Led by **Xoli Msimanga**; shares the hope of Christ to the sick and orphaned through home health care in response to HIV, provides community health services in a remote mountain area.
