

Endowment Fund Grant History

Since 2015 the Community Church Endowment Fund has awarded over \$218,000 in grants. Approximately 16% of the funds were used for church initiatives with the remainder being granted to area non-profits. The individual grants range from \$1,500 to \$22,114 and are in addition to funds provided through our Missions budget. Following is a summary of the larger grants awarded over the years by organization.

The grants that were awarded for church initiatives covered a range of projects including unanticipated audio upgrades and computer replacements, a contribution for the replacement of the Founder's Chapel organ, and the initial funding for the Pastoral Resident program. Internal grants total \$37,000.
