Since by his death, resurrection, and ascension he has obtained for us the life-giving Spirit who unites us all in one body, so we are to receive this Supper in true love, mindful of the communion of saints. Come, for all things are now ready! The Lord be with you! **And also with you.**

Lift up your hearts! **We lift them up to the Lord.**

Let us give thanks to the Lord our God. **For it is holy and right to do so.**

Let us pray. Holy and righteous God, with all the company of heaven, we worship and adore your most glorious name, saying together...
