CCTV Mission Outreach will continue our efforts to help our neighbors recover from Hurricane Helene's disastrous floods. The damage was extensive and our assistance continues to be needed. CCTV will once again work with **Holston Habitat for Humanity** that serves upper East Tennessee where over 1,100 homes were damaged or destroyed.

CCTV Disaster Recovery Mission Trip

WHEN: Monday, April 20 – Thursday, April 23, 2026

WHERE: Upper East Tennessee (Washington or Carter County)

-- Work site will be determined by Holston Habitat for Humanity

WHO: CCTV members who are interested in helping to build new homes for families that were displaced due to the flood. Skills needed include light construction, painting, electrical, or other building skills. All are welcome – there will be jobs for both men and women! Work sites will be supervised by a certified Habitat for Humanity foreman.

COST: \$150 per person, double occupancy or \$300 per person for a private room

This fee includes 3 nights lodging, all meals, and transportation to/from our work site; additional financial support will be from the CCTV Disaster Response funds contributed by our congregation.
